**ORDER:-**

In continuation of the G.O read above, it is clarified that the Disciplinary Authority viz., Secretaries to Government, shall exercise the power to impose all penalties **except** major penalty of dismissal / removal. Cases deserving imposition of major penalty of dismissal / removal, shall be submitted to the Hon'ble Lieutenant Governor viz., the Appointing Authority.

2. In matters where the Secretary to Government has imposed penalty other than dismissal / removal as Disciplinary Authority, the appeal shall lie with the Administrator in terms of clause (i)(a) of Sub-rule (1) of Rule 24 of CCS (CCA) Rules, 1965.

3. This is issued in order to comply with the Article 311 (1) of the Constitution.
