STANDING ORDERS

In exercise of the powers conferred under Rule 18 of the Rules of Business of the Government of Pondicherry 1963 and in supersession of the Standing Order issued in General Administration Department No.28-2/85-GAD/SS.I(1) dated 23rd March, 1985 the Hon'ble Chief Minister (Minister in charge of Home, Law, Finance etc) hereby issues the following Standing Orders specifying the matters to be brought to his personal notice through proper channel in addition to the cases which are otherwise required to be submitted to the Chief Minister under the said Business Rules.

1. All important vigilance matters.
2. All important communications and matters received from and sent to Government of India and other State Governments.
3. All proposals having important legal or financial implications.
4. Formulation of all new plans schemes
5. Matters connected with the personal establishment of Ministers.
6. Cases of taking of lease of private buildings for Government purpose whenever the rate of rent is proposed to be fixed in excess of the normal standard licence fees.
