(Unless he is out of station)

- 2. But of late, it has been brought to the notice of the Government that the delay occurring in disposal of files/processing of proposals at various levels of Government adversely affects the functioning of the Administration inviting adverse criticism.
- 3. It is therefore reiterated that the time limit stipulated in the standing order cited above shall be strictly adhered to in the best interest of the administration and to ensure effective delivery of public service.
