In the G.O first read above, Departmental Tests have been prescribed for the officers and staff of Directorate of Economics and Statistics, Pondicherry. 3. The revised syllabi of the Departmental Test in Statistics for Field Supervisors and other details are given in the Annexure to this order. The syllabus of the Accounts Test for Executive Officers has been prescribed in G.O.Ms.No.74, dated 30.08.1972 of the Appointments Department, Pondicherry read with G.O.Ms.No.52/74-(Exam), dated 01.06.1974 of the General Administration Department, Pondicherry.

- The tests will be conducted by the Department of Personnel and Administrative Reforms (Personnel Wing), Chief Secretariat, Pondicherry subject to the conditions to be notified by them from time to time and on the dates and centres to be intimated separately.
