Public Services - Departmental Tests - Relaxation of Rules for
exempting Government Servants from passing the tests -
Instructions - Issued.

ORDER :-

Proposals for relaxation of rules for exempting the Government Servants from passing the departmental tests etc., are on the increase. Such relaxations are made on the merits of each case. Though such relaxations are made after detailed examination of the merits of each case, it is necessary to have norms laid down for observance. Accordingly, the Government have examined the question of relaxation of rules for exempting the Government Servants from passing the departmental tests etc., as a measure of policy commonly applicable to all departments and it has been decided that the cases for relaxation of rules for exempting Government Servants, from passing the departmental tests should satisfy the following criteria:

- (i) The Government Servant asking exemption should be more than 50 years of age (Should have completed 50 years).
- (ii) He should have made at least five attempts to pass the test, by sitting for the test.
- (iii) His record of service should be such as to merit the concession.

2. Departments of the Secretariat and all Heads of Departments are requested to take into account the above factors while recommending cases for relaxation of rules.


