

N O T I F I C A T I O N

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India read with the Notification No.F.5/4/65-OP dated 11th January, 1965 of the Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India, New Delhi, and in supersession of the Notification issued in G.O.Ms.No.69 dated 1st August 1981 of the General Administration Department in so far as it relates to schedule VII annexed thereto and published in the Extraordinary Gazette No.77 dated 1st August 1981, save as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the Lieutenant Governor, Pondicherry hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Superintendent Grade I in Secretariat and Non-Secretariat Departments, Government of Pondicherry, namely:-

1. Short title and commencement.- (1) These rules may be called the Government of Pondicherry (Superintendent Grade I) Recruitment Rules, 1991.
(2) They shall come into force on and from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. Number of post, its classification and scale of pay.- The number of the said post, its classification and scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of Schedule annexed hereto.
3. Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications.- The method of recruitment to the said post, age, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be specified in columns (5) to (8) of the said Schedule.
4. Disqualifications.- No person,
 - (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
 - (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,shall be eligible for appointment to the said post.

Provided that the Lieutenant Governor may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax. Where the Lieutenant Governor is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission.

6. Saving.— Nothing in these rules shall affect the reservations, relaxation in upper age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Government from time to time in this regard.

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SCHEDULE

1. Name of Post Superintendent Grade I
2. Number of Posts 86 (1991). Subject to variation dependent on workload.
3. Classification General Central Service Group 'B' Gazetted.
4. Scale of Pay Rs. 1640-60-2600-EB-75-2900
5. Whether selection post or non-selection post Selection
6. Age limit for direct recruits Not applicable
7. Whether benefit of added years of service admissible under rule 30 of the Central Civil Services (Pension) Rules, 1972. Not applicable
8. Educational and other qualifications required for direct recruits Not applicable
9. Whether age and educational qualifications prescribed for direct recruits shall apply in the case of Promotees Not applicable
- Period of probation, if any 2 Years
- Method of recruitment. Whether by direct recruitment or by promotion or by deputation/transfer and percentage of the vacancies to be filled by various methods
- (i) 66 2/3% by promotion; and
- (ii) 33 1/3% by transfer on deputation failing which by promotion.

Note: The posts may be allowed to be filled 100% by promotion if the field of selection for promotion consisting of Superintendents Grade II holding posts on regular basis and having requisite qualifying service is more than five times the number of vacancies occurring in a year, otherwise the posts may be filled by the method as laid down above.

Transfer on deputation
Officers of the Central Government/
Union territories:-

- (a) (i) holding analogous posts on
regular basis; or
(ii) with 5 years' regular service
in posts in the scale of
Rs.1400-2600 or equivalent;
and
b) possessing experience in
Establishment/Accounts
matters.

The departmental officers in the
lower category who are in the direct
line of promotion will not be eligible
or consideration for appointment on
deputation. Similarly, deputationists
shall not be eligible for consideration
for appointment by promotion. Period
of deputation including period of
deputation in another ex-cadre post
held immediately preceding this appoint-
ment in the same or some other organi-
sation/department of the Central
Government shall ordinarily not to
exceed 3 years).

Note 1: For computing the 2 years
service, the service rendered in the
post of Superintendent (Non-Secretariat)
and the service rendered after 1st
January 1973 and upto 31st July 1981
in the post of Assistant shall be
taken into account.

Provided that the Superinten-
dent (Non-Secretariat) in service as
on 31st December, 1972 shall on bloc
be senior to Assistants in service on
that date and the Superintendents
(Non-Secretariat) and Assistants
appointed on or after 1st January, 1973
and upto 31st July, 1981 shall rank
in order with reference to their date
of appointment in the respective
posts.

Note 2: The suitability of the regular
holders of the posts of Superintendent
Grade I prior to the upgradation as
gazetted posts will be initially
assessed for appointment to the upgraded
posts. If assessed suitable, he/she
shall be deemed to have been appointed
to the post at the initial constitution.
If assessed 'not suitable' for appoint-
ment to the gazetted post, he shall
continue to be in the non-gazetted
post and his case would be reviewed
every year.

Group 'B' DPC (for considering promotion)

1. Chief Secretary - Chairman
2. Secretary-cum-Development Commissioner - Member
3. Joint Secretary (Department of Personnel & Administrative Reforms) - Member.

Circumstances in which Union Public Service Commission is to be consulted in making recruitment

Consultation with the Union Public Service Commission not necessary.
