
RECRUITMENT RULES FOR THE POST OF DRIVER (LMV) GRADE-I

1. Name of the post : Driver (LMV) Grade-I
2. Number of post : 158 (one hundred and fifty eight) (2010) subject to variation dependent on work load
3. Classification : General Central Services
Group C. Non-gazetted - Non-Ministerial
4. Pay Band and Grade Pay / Pay scale : Pay Band - 1
Rs. 5,200-20,200 + Grade Pay Rs.2,800
5. Whether selection post or non-selection post : Non-selection.
6. Whether benefit of added years of service admissible under Rule 30 of CCS (Pension) Rules, 1972. : Not applicable.
7. Age limit for direct recruits : Not applicable.
8. Educational and other qualification required for direct recruits : Not applicable.
9. Whether age and educational qualifications prescribed for direct recruits will apply in the case of promotees : Not applicable.
10. Period of probation, if any : Not applicable.
11. Method of recruitment, whether by direct recruitment or by promotion or by deputation / absorption and percentage of the vacancies to be filled by various methods : By promotion.
12. In case of recruitment by promotion / deputation / absorption, grades from which promotion / deputation / absorption is to be made. : Promotion from Driver (LMV) Grade-II with 5 years regular service in the grade failing which combined service of 13 years in Grade-III and Grade-II; of which not less than 3 years of regular service should have been rendered in the post of Driver (LMV) Grade-II.

Provided when a junior in Driver (LMV) Grade-II is considered for promotion, all his seniors will also be considered for promotion.

Note: For the purpose of computing minimum qualifying service for promotion, the service rendered on regular basis by an official prior to 01-01-2006, the date from which the revised pay structure based on the 6th CPC recommendations has been extended, shall be deemed to be service rendered in the corresponding grade pay / pay scale.
