**ANNEXURE**

*(to G.O. Ms. No. 19 dated 26.02.2026)*

1. **Pay**: During the period of deputation, the Officer shall have the option either to get his pay fixed in the deputation post under the operation of the normal rules or to draw pay of the post held by him in his parent department plus a Deputation (Duty) Allowance in accordance with the instructions contained in O.M. No.6/8/2009-Estt.(Pay.II) dated 17.06.2010 of Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances & Pensions, Department of Personnel & Training as communicated vide this Department's I.D. Note/Memorandum No.A.35011/1/2002/DPAR/CCD(2) dated 06.01.2011.
2. **Dearness Allowance**: The Officer shall be entitled to Dearness Allowance under the rules of the parent department or under the rules of the borrowing department according as he retains the scale of pay under the parent department or he draws pay in the scale attached to the post under borrowing department.
3. **Local Allowances and HRA**: These allowances shall be regulated under the rules of the borrowing department.
4. **Children's Educational Allowance**: The Officer shall be entitled either to claim the Children's Education Allowance from the State Government as laid down in para.1(a) of Finance Ministry's O.M. No.8(II)E.II(B)/63, dated 12.08.1964 subject to the fulfillment of the condition prescribed in O.M.No.F.16(1). Estt.(Spl)/60 dated 30.01.1962 as amended from time to time or to reimbursement of tuition fees in respect of her children, subject to the fulfillment of the terms and conditions laid down in Finance Ministry's O.M. No.17(1)E.II(B)/64 dated 03.06.1964 as amended from time to time and liability in this regard shall devolve on the borrowing department.
5. **Joining Time Pay and Transfer Travelling Allowance**: The Officer shall be entitled to the Transfer Travelling Allowance and Joining Time on joining the post on deputation and on reversion to the parent department under the Central Civil Services (Joining Time) Rules, 1979. The expenditure on this account will be borne by the borrowing department.
6. **Travelling Allowance for Journey on duty during the period of deputation**: This shall be regulated under the rules of the service as applicable to Judicial Officers in the Grade of District Judge under the Government of Puducherry.
7. **Leave and Pension**: During the period of deputation on temporary transfer, the Officer shall continue to be governed by the leave and pension rules of the parent department applicable to him before such transfer. The allocation of leave salary and pensionary charges will be regulated as per rules in force.
8. **Provident Fund Benefits**: During the period of deputation, the Officer shall continue to subscribe to the Provident Fund on his parent department to which he has been subscribing when he was placed on deputation, in accordance with the rules of such fund.
9. **Leave Travel Concession**: The Officer shall be entitled to Leave Travel Concession as admissible to the employees of Government of Puducherry.
10. **Medical Concession and Residential Accommodation**: The Officer shall be entitled to these concessions under the rules of service as applicable to the Judicial Officers in the grade of District Judge under the Govt. of Puducherry.
11. During the period of deputation, the officer shall be entitled to draw other allowances and benefits wherever applicable, as specified in G.O.Ms.No.62/2006-LD, dated 08.09.2006 of the Law Department, Puducherry.
