

Annexure to order No. A. 35016/2015/DPAR/CCUI dt. 21/12/2015

1. PAY: During the period of deputation, Tmt. P.R. Sanoopa, LDC will have the option either to get her pay fixed in the deputation post under the operation of the normal rules or to draw pay of the post held by her in her parent Department plus deputation (duty) allowance in accordance with and subject to the conditions laid down in O.M. No.6/8/2009-Estt.(PAY II) dated 17.06.2010 of the Government of India, Department of Personnel & Training, as modified from time to time.
2. DEARNESS ALLOWANCE AND OTHER ALLOWANCES : During the period of foreign service she will be entitled to dearness allowance under the rules of the parent Government or under, the rules of the borrowing authority as she retains the scale of pay under the parent Government or she may draw pay in the scale attached to the post under the borrowing authority.
3. LEAVE: During the period of foreign service, she will continue to be governed by the leave rules applicable to her in her parent Departments.
4. DISABILITY LEAVE: The borrowing authority will be liable to pay leave salary in respect of special disability leave granted to the above official on account of any disability incurred through foreign service under the borrowing authority even if such disability manifests itself after the termination of deputation
5. COMPENSATORY ALLOWANCE: The whole expenditure in respect of Compensatory Allowance for the period of leave in or at the end of the foreign service shall be borne by the borrowing authority.
6. TRAVELLING ALLOWANCE: For journey on duty in foreign service, the travelling allowance rules of the Central Government would apply.
7. LEAVE TRAVEL CONCESSION: During the period of foreign service, she will be entitled to Leave Travel Concession as admissible under the Central Government Rules, the liability in this regard being borne by the borrowing authority.
8. MEDICAL FACILITIES: During the period of foreign service, she will be entitled to medical facilities and educational concession not inferior to those she would have enjoyed had she remained in the service of the Government.
9. CONTRIBUTIONS: The leave salary and pension contributions will be paid by the borrowing authority. Contribution for leave salary or pension due in respect of the Government servant in foreign service may be paid annually within fifteen days from the end of each financial year or at the end of the foreign service if the deputation on foreign service expires before the end of the financial year and if the payment is not made within the said period, interest must be paid to Government on the unpaid contributions, unless it is specifically remitted by the President at the rate of two paise per day for Rs. 100/- from the date of expiry of the period aforesaid up to the date on which the contributions is finally paid. The interest shall be paid by the Government servant or the foreign employer accordingly as the contributions is paid by the former or the later. The leave salary and pension contributions should be paid separately as they are creditable to different heads of accounts and no dues, recoverable from the Government servant on any account should be set off against these contributions.
