 The fee payable will be %.5/- even if a part/paper of a particular test is to be written.
- 3. The number of attempts for purpose of collection of free, till calculated based on the various departmental tost/examination which will be conducted after the issue of this order.
- 4. The fee is payable by Indian Postal Order payable to the deputy secretary to Coronment, Coneral Administration Department, Pondicherry (by designation only).

 5. Hees once paid will not be refunded on any account.
- 6. Applications without the Indian Postal order will be summarily rejected.
- 7. Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe and Ex-servicement candidates are exempted from payment of fee for departmental tests.
 8. L. D. Ug/Werks are exempted from payment of fee for departmental test in Typewriting only.
- 2. In supersession of the earlier proces, the following instructions are issued for strict compliance in so far as admission of candidates to the departmental tests are concerned:-
